2025 TELEPHONE CHANGES REPORTED EARLIER

The UK's telephone network is being upgraded, which means that landline services are changing. You'll still be able to have a landline in your home, but the technology that powers it will be a bit different and you may need to upgrade some of your equipment. If you don't have a mobile, live somewhere where there's no or poor signal, or depend on your landline, for example, because you're disabled, your home phone provider should offer you a solution like a battery-operated handset. This will mean that you can make emergency calls during a power cut.
